In person Screening Protocols

- One guardian with each child.
- Siblings must remain home, unless the sibling is a young infant and needs to be with the caregiver.
- Call 952-442-0613 to alert staff that you have arrived for your screening appointment. Remain in your car until a staff person greets you and health questions have been confirmed.
- Adults and children must sanitize hands upon entering and exiting the building.
- Entrance doors different from the exit doors.
- All high touch surfaces and materials sanitized between screening appointments.

Health Check

- Complete a health check at home, prior to your appointment. If you have any of the symptoms listed please stay home and reschedule your appointment.

Face Covering

- Staff are required to wear face coverings and/or shields when providing direct service.
- Caregivers are required to wear face coverings within the building.
